UTV Tour Rules & Safety Guidelines

1. Driver Requirements

The driver of the buggy must hold a valid driver's license and present it prior to the tour. Only licensed drivers are permitted to operate the buggy; any violation may result in immediate removal from the tour without a refund.

License Copy Authorization

By renting a UTV, the renter grants Kadushi Rental permission to take and retain a copy of their valid driver's license for the duration of the rental period. This copy is solely for verification and recordkeeping purposes and will be handled in compliance with privacy regulations.

2. Safety Guidelines

Seatbelts: All passengers must wear seatbelts at all times.

Speed Limits: Maintain a safe and reasonable speed, especially on rough or uneven terrains.

Road Awareness: Stay alert to other vehicles, pedestrians, and road conditions. Buggies are not designed for extreme offroad use.

No Reckless Driving: Any form of reckless or unsafe driving is strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate removal from the tour.

3. Alcohol and Drugs

Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly forbidden. Violation of this rule will result in immediate removal from the tour and potential reporting to authorities.

4. Equipment Care

Avoid sharp turns, steep inclines, or unsafe driving conditions that could result in tipping or damage. Follow all maintenance and operation instructions provided by the tour guide.

5. Insurance Coverage

ThirdParty Coverage Only: The tour includes thirdparty liability insurance only, covering damages to others but not to the rental buggy.

Damage Responsibility: The participant is fully responsible for any abnormal damage caused to the buggy during the tour. This includes accidents, wear from misuse, or neglect.

6. Environmental Respect

Refrain from disturbing local wildlife or vegetation. Only use designated paths or roads to avoid environmental damage.

7. Liability Agreement

By participating in a buggy tour with Kadushi Rental, participants agree to all rules and take full responsibility for any damages or legal implications arising from misuse or negligence.

8. Emergency Procedures

In case of an emergency, follow the safety instructions provided and contact Kadushi Rental immediately for assistance.

9. Deposit Policy

A refundable deposit is required before the tour. The deposit will be returned in full upon inspection if the UTV is returned in the same condition as it was delivered, with no damages or missing parts.

Any damage, excessive wear, or loss of equipment will result in a partial or full deduction from the deposit to cover repair or replacement costs.

10. No Overtaking

For safety reasons, overtaking other buggies is strictly prohibited during the tour. This rule ensures the safety of all participants and helps prevent accidents due to reckless driving.
